APPLICATION TO BE TURNED IN ON THE FIRST DAY OF CLINIC

Thank you for your interest in the 2017-18 Acalanes High School Cheer Team!

Please read through the packet to get a better understanding of expectations. Cheerleading is now a recognized Varsity Sport and subjected to rules and regulations including and not limited to — Practice, Game Day, School Attendance, GPA, Code of Conduct. Students & families must be committed to post-tryout training schedule, 2017-18 squad seasons, practice and summer training.

Spectators not allowed during clinic or tryout

3-DAY CLINIC APRIL 17-19, 2017 MONDAY-WEDNESDAY 5:30-7:30PM
During the mandatory 3-Day Clinic participants learn cheers, skill techniques, working in small teams and choreographed routines.

TRYOUT DAY APRIL 21, 2017 FRIDAY 5:30-7:30PM
On Tryout Day, participants will perform their assigned group's routine in front of coaches and any AHS administration.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING & WEAR?

- Tryout Application Packet (Tryout Application, Parent & Student Agreement, Medical Waiver, Code of Conduct, Photo Release).
- Recent photo.
- OUTFIT— A white t-shirt (no writing on shirt) and black shorts. Shoes and socks are a **must**. Previously used AHS cheer shirts may not be worn.
- HAIR — Needs to be pulled back and secured in a high pony tail. No bangs please. Ribbons may be worn in hair.
- WATER!!!
- NO jewelry may be worn.
- NO long or acrylic nails or nail polish.
- NO “over-the-top” make up.

MAKING THE TEAM

PLACEMENT Please note that Freshmen will not be placed on Varsity. A participant trying out for Varsity Spirit Squad may be placed on the Junior Varsity Squad.

OFFER ACCEPTANCE Upon receiving an email making the 2017-18 AHS Cheer Team, you will need to reply that you accept your spot on the listed squad. Spring training will start promptly after roster is finalized.



SPIRIT, STUNT & COMPETITION SQUADS

What's the difference?

SPIRIT

SPIRIT is divided into Junior Varsity & Varsity squads. SPIRIT performs general cheer and choreographed routines. Cheerleaders can opt to try out for SPIRIT ONLY.
